

**Shattemuc Yacht Club – 33rd Annual Pedlow Cup – Sunday Oct 9, 2011
(Independence Day Makeup Race) 2:00 pm pre-race skippers' meeting;
2:30 pm – race starts (depending on wind)**

NOTICE OF RACE –SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES - The Pedlow Cup race will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. ENTRY - The SYC Pedlow Cup is open to all members of Shattemuc and guests. Yachts may pre-register if possible, however late entrants may meet at the starting line at the time of the race. Please honor the “Pedlow Ideal” when selecting skipper and crew.
3. RACE COURSE – The race course is usually announced on the clubhouse deck at the meeting, but may change due to weather conditions or other. A change in the race course will be made over VHF Channel 72 before the start. There may be more than one race and the course will be confirmed over the radio.
4. PRE AMBLE – Please sail past the committee boat, check your radio and register by reporting your sail number and boat name. Channel 72.
5. START – The starting line is between a white flag on the Committee Boat and a white or orange ball float.

There will be a Preparatory call-out on VHF Channel 72 and several short blasts from the committee boat about six (6) minutes before the start to confirm the course and announce the 5 minute start sequence.

Following this, the start sequence will be as described in RR26, modified as follows and without the use of signal flags.

The first blast you hear will be the Warning (5 minute) signal.
The next blast you hear will be the Preparatory (4 minute) signal
 There will be a radio announcement at 3 minutes.
 There will be a radio announcement at 2 minutes.
The next LONG blast you hear will be the 1-minute signal
The next blast will be the START.

6. FINISH - The finish line will be put up after the start in the vicinity of the start line. The finish line is between a white flag on the Committee Boat and a white ball float.
